S4C Programmes to Watch Out For

Keep an eye on the S4C schedules for details of programmes which could be useful for your lessons. Children's services **Cyw**, for very young children, and **Stwnsh** aimed at 7-13 year olds are a great place to start and the rest of the schedule is also peppered with useful content. Here are just a few.

T. Llew Jones. This October saw the centenary of the birth of the acclaimed Welsh author. To commemorate, S4C scheduled several special programmes about the late author and poet, including a new documentary **T. Llew Jones** and, from the archive, the film adaptation of his classic novel, **Tân ar y Comin**. All programmes available online until the second week in November.

#Fi. Award-winning documentary series reflecting the diverse lives of youngsters. Featuring a range of topics, from personal difficulties to extraordinary experiences. Every Wednesday at 5.20 and catch up online.

Dyma Fi. A week of special programmes in November for young people. Includes special debate programme **Hacio'n Holi** as secondary school children debate topics which matter to them.

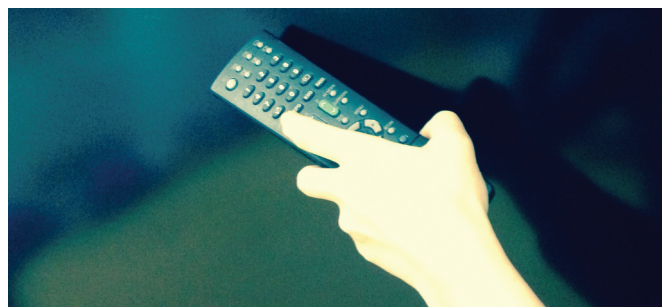
Arfordir Cymru: Llŷn. A new series which explores the history, the people and the landscape of the Llŷn Peninsula. Starts Sunday 8 November 7.30.

Jen a Jim Pob Dim. A series all about mathematics, and follows the curriculum for **Foundation Phase** (ages 4-5). Based in a shop, run by lively characters Jen and Jim, mathematical problems are presented in a fun and colourful way, encouraging children to get involved. Part of the **Cyw** service and will also include online games and activities.

Most programmes are available with **English subtitles**.

PSHE Teaching – Llond Ceg

PSHE is currently a non-statutory subject, however schools are required to make provision for PSHE Education, drawing on 'good practice'.

Finding resource and support materials for this subject can be difficult given the broad frameworks currently provided. Helpfully, S4C has developed '**Llond Ceg**', a series discussing and debating the issues important to young people with subjects covered ranging from self-image to divorce, relationships and social media.

Presented by Radio 1's Surgery presenter Aled Haydn Jones, co-presented by Kizzy Crawford and Geraint Hardy, the series is designed for children aged 8-14 and English subtitles are available. Your ERA Licence ensures you can make copies of any of these programmes and show clips (or whole programmes) to you class, or ask pupils to view them at home prior to classroom discussions.

In partnership with Childline, NSPCC and the Children's Commissioner for Wales they have also produced an excellent free app available to download from iTunes and Google Play.

Adding Value to the ERA Licence

Schools in Wales are licensed mainly through group licence arrangements with local authorities, or in a small number of cases, on an individual basis. As a not for profit organisation, ERA only cover our administration costs from the money we collect from licensing. We pay everything else to our Members. This ensures that Rightsholders are being paid fairly for the work they have created. Arfordir Cymru: Llŷn. Cyfres newydd sy'n dechrau ar nos Sul 8 Tachwedd 7.30, ac sy'n archwilio hanes, pobl a thirwedd arfordir Pen Llŷn.

Jen a Jim Pob Dim. Cyfres am rifau a rhifydded yn addas ar gyfer **Cyfnod Sylfaen** (oed 4-5). Wedi ei gosod mewn siop, yng ngofal y cymeriadau Jen a Jim, mae'r gyfres yn cyflwyno problemau mathemateg mewn ffordd liwgar a hwyllog, i annog plant i gymryd rhan. Rhan o wasanaeth **Cyw** fydd hefyd yn cynnwys gemau a gweithgareddau ar-lein.

Addysg Bersonol a Chymdeithasol – Llund Ceg
