General Rules

- This competition is being run by the Educational Recording Agency Ltd (ERA), which hosts the Natural Curriculum website. (<https://www.naturalcurriculum.co.uk>). Our address is Scott House, Suite 1 The Concourse, Waterloo Station, London, SE1 7LY
- The prize draw is open to registered users of the Natural Curriculum, aged 18 and over, from schools in the United Kingdom which hold an ERA Licence. With very few exceptions, state-funded schools in the UK are covered by centralised licensing arrangements, while independent schools tend to be licensed individually. - Employees of ERA and their immediate families are ineligible for entry in the prize draw.

Prize Draw Entry

- To enter the prize draw, entrants must complete all required fields in the Natural Curriculum Feedback Survey and enter their registered email address when they submit the form.
- Multiple or joint entries will not be considered.

- The ERA Website Feedback Survey opens at 9.00am on Thursday 21st May 2026 and closes at 11.59pm on Thursday 11th June 2026. Entry into the prize draw is contingent on completing the ERA Website Feedback Survey in this period.

Prize and Winner

- The prize draw winner will be selected at random from the entries received by ERA.

- The winner of the prize draw will be contacted by email by Tuesday 16th June 2026.

Limitation of liability
